History and Development AutoCAD came into existence when Autodesk bought Concatenated Drafting Systems, a developer of drafting and plotting products. The first version of AutoCAD was released in December 1982, and by 1987 it was in widespread use among designers and architects throughout the world. AutoCAD's roots were in previous programs developed by Concatenated. CAD was the company's first foray into computing. Concatenated's first CAD product, Digitizer, was a combination hand-drawn drafting-plotting system developed by Tom Antonion. The first CAD programs were first sold in the mid-1970s. Although the basic technology has remained unchanged, the core functionality has been gradually enhanced with new features and new functionality. For example, the BITE system was introduced in 1993. Other notable features have included the ability to seamlessly move from 2D to 3D design and the implementation of the direct creation of 3D models from 2D drawings, using what is now known as 2.5D technology. During the development of AutoCAD, an Autodesk team of six developers located in Seattle, California, and Melbourne, Australia, created the first versions of AutoCAD. These developers were: Don Keyser: AutoCAD's primary architect and developer. Paul Cummings: Lead developer of the BITE feature. Paddy Patterson: Lead designer on the mouse functionality. Dan Malone: Head of the graphics team. Wujiang Peng: Lead developer of the CALM feature. Andrew Naimo: Lead developer of the PREVIEW feature. Additional team members included Gerry Chappell, one of Concatenated's developers, who joined the Autodesk team. Although each member of the Autodesk team worked on AutoCAD for a period of time, there was no formal

hierarchy. The Autodesk team worked mostly on its own, with shared ideas and planning sessions. This allowed for the best of all technologies to be integrated into the product, according to the "anytime/anywhere" philosophy that is synonymous with the practice of agile development. As the development process developed, the Autodesk team felt that changes were being made too slowly. At this point in time, the underlying technology was becoming dated, and they felt that it was not moving fast enough. "They didn't know where the next CAD project was going to come from,"

Since Autodesk Inventor and Google SketchUp discontinued support of PDF natively in 2011 and 2012 respectively, the only AutoCAD Crack For Windows-compatible vector graphics and PDF formats are the native format or via OpenOffice Draw. Autodesk Revit and Navisworks are compatible with the.DWG, DWF and DXF.2 formats, which are the native formats of AutoCAD Free Download. All of these formats are supported by most AutoCAD Crack Mac users. File compression Autodesk's native format is the DWG format, which is designed to allow for large, complex drawing data to be compressed, allowing data transmission over slower links such as the Internet. In 2010, Autodesk released a third-party format called the DWF and DXF Encryption Standard (DXF/Enc) format. This format is based on a combination of the standard DXF/Enc format and the DGN Encryption Standard (DGN/Enc), used in other CAD applications such as AutoCAD LT and Google SketchUp. Autodesk is one of a few CAD software providers that provides encryption for many different file formats, such as the DWG and DWF formats. Other CAD providers include PTC, SolidWorks and Trimble, but Autodesk is the only CAD provider that provides native support for DWF. Easily incorporate feedback into existing drawings. Send feedback from a PDF or paper file to the workspace or to a drawing. Add and update text and measurements with no additional drawing steps. (video: 1:05 min.) Shared Linking: One thing you'll notice right away about shared link is its simplicity. The benefits of a shared link include that you can set up a drawing in another drawing to avoid saving edits (saving a copy with each update is very time consuming, so you'll want to avoid it). With a shared link you don't have to worry about saving the file or worrying about the original. Any changes you make will automatically appear in the linked drawing. This is true whether you're the one editing the file or someone else. You'll be prompted for an author, since you'll be working in the linked drawing, and that author will be the one who makes the changes. A shared link is one way you can maintain a consistent workspace between files. You can also share a drawing with a colleague, someone on another team, or for collaboration. You can do this by creating a shared link and sending it to a

colleague. If they click on that shared link, they will immediately see all the updates. If you also use AutoCAD as your video camera software, you can send a link from your video clip.
